In lieu of furnishing you with the specific evidence of our authority in connection with any Ameritas or other order for which we give you, we represent that we have specific authority from them to enter into such transactions on their behalf. However, at your request, we can provide you with the names and addresses of our clients if you need to supplement the information available through the Omgeo Alert system. We agree to indemnify and hold you harmless in the event that a client should make a claim against you that your execution of any order on the basis of our instruction was without authority.

Further, you may rely on our assurance that we are satisfied that the person or persons who signed our contract were themselves properly authorized to do so. Moreover, based upon our review of these documents and other relevant information regarding our clients, we have satisfied ourselves that the orders we place through you are suitable for them. Additionally, we represent to you that we have no plans to participate in equity IPO transactions and will inform you if we modify that position. We will indemnify and hold you harmless in the event a client should make claim against you that any transaction we entered into on its behalf was not suitable.

This letter covers all accounts now established with your firm, as well as any future accounts we may establish, and remains in effect until canceled in writing.
