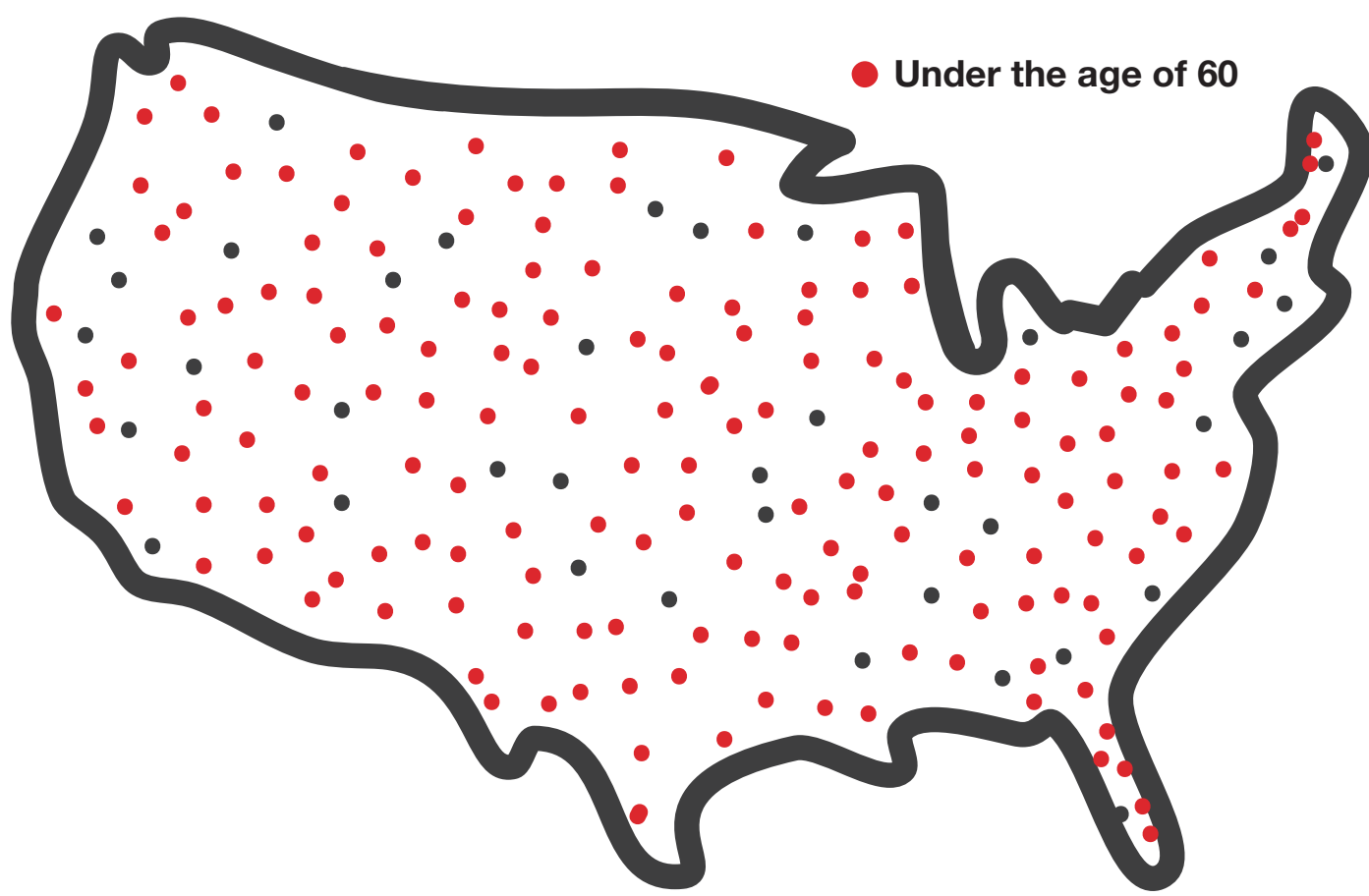


# Student loan debt in the U.S. is over \$1.7 trillion<sup>1</sup>

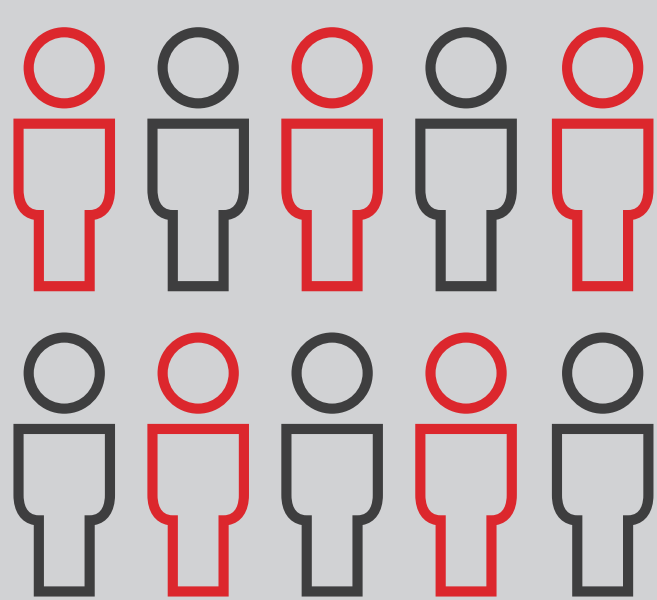


**69%** of college graduates in 2019 had student loan debt<sup>2</sup>
